AGREED ORDER STAYING THE CASE

This matter was considered on the Department's Agreed Motion To Stay the Case for the reasons that were fully discussed during the case management conference (the "Hearing") on June 2, 2025, involving the same attorneys and the same judge in Apple, Inc. v. State of Florida Department of Revenue, 2d Judicial Circuit Case No. 2024-CA-1484 ("Apple").

The Court was fully informed of the reasons for the requested stay and has determined that those reasons are sufficiently compelling to justify the requested relief. The Court also was advised during the Hearing that Plaintiff does not object to the requested relief and that the requested stay

will not prejudice any party because the Department has agreed to waive all claims to interest accruing during the time that this case is stayed.

For the reasons stated above, it is hereby

ORDERED:

1. That this case is stayed for the ninety-day period beginning June 16, 2025, and ending September 15, 2025.

2. All deadlines in this case, including the discovery deadline in the original case management order, are temporarily suspended, and will be reset during a case management conference after September 15, 2025, which will be scheduled by a separate order.
